# I can't see my AccurRender library folders? How do I make the folders visible in Vista?

1. Go to Start and pick on Control Panel. From Control Panel, double click on the icon *Folder Options*.



2. In the Folder Options dialog, pick on the View tab. In the Advanced Settings List, scroll to Hidden Files and Folders, and highlight the radio button next to Show hidden files and folder.

### How do I remove the AccuRender 4 program?

1. From Start, pick on Computer.



2. In the **Computer** dialog, select the **Uninstall or Change a Program** button across the top of the window.



3. From the **Uninstall or Change a Program** window, highlight the application and pick on the **Uninstall/Change** button across the top of the window.



### How do I disable the default Vista User Account security?

Windows Vista will run most applications with standard user permissions even if the user is an administrator. If a user wishes to run a program that requires administrator permissions, they must give consent through a User Account Control prompt. This helps limit user's ability to make system-wide changes without the administrator's knowledge. Administrator Approval Mode does not provide the same level of security or control as a true standard user account. To disable this User Account Control:
