Certified Exam Rules

As a Rhino Certified Provider, you must read and agree to the following:

Before the Exam:

- Input Testers names to test.com one week before exam day.
- Email Mary Ann Fugier <u>mary@mcneel.com</u> to confirm test credits.
 (Test Credits are purchased from McNeel at an Educational Cost of 20 exams for \$100.)

During the Exam:

- Proctor must be present while students are taking test.
- If proctor needs to leave, he needs to leave another certified teacher in charge.
- Proctor should not be absent from testing environment more than 15 minutes total.
- Each student is required to use the same personal email address for all exams.
- Students must take their own exams. However a proctor can help input answers, if this is an approved accommodation for the student.
- Testing must be completed in 3 hours or 180 minutes.
- Students may have up to 3 breaks can pause and restart exam up to 3 times. (typical break schedule 10 minutes after 60 & 120 minutes of testing.)
- Students should not discuss the exam questions while at break.
- Two (2) no-charge Retakes within one year of test, will be offered to both those that pass and fail. First retake allowed after 2 days wait period. Second retake allowed after 14 days wait period. (This will also give testers who pass and want to improve their scores, a good option.)
